ELECTIVE CREDIT FOR EMPLOYMENT WITH HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS

High school students in grades 11 and 12 can earn elective credits if employed by an eligible health care provider. Beginning Sept. 1, 2023, students may earn one (1) elective credit for every 350 hours worked, including hours worked during the summer. Students may earn up to two (2) elective credits each year under this program.

Eligible Employers:

- Long-term care facility
- Licensed assisted living
- Home and community-based services provider
- Hospital or health system clinic
- Childcare center

After you have completed 350 hours, please complete the application below in order to receive credits. Please send the completed application to HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT / COUNSELING DEPARTMENT. Minnewaska Area High School will verify the hours worked with the employer after the application has been submitted. If approved, credits will appear on a student's transcript as "Health Care Employment Experience".
